List any leadership experience with any of the above.
- Please include at least three (3) letters of recommendation. The letters of recommendation must be the original.
- The applicant must have been involved with the Northeast Florida Fair for a minimum of two (2) years.
- The applicant must be a high school senior, enrolled or planning to enroll in a college, university, or technical education.
- To be eligible a student must reside in one of the following counties in Florida: Nassau, Duval, Clay, Baker, or St. Johns.

- Scholarship funds are assigned directly to the winner's choice of college, university, or technical institution.
