The applicant's essay should briefly discuss the youths background, lists of any awards or special recognition from the Northeast Florida Fair, community, high school, agricultural organizations (4-H, FFA, or other fairs). List any leadership experience with any of the above.

-Please include at least three (3) letters of recommendation. The letters of recommendation must be the original.

-The applicant <u>must</u> have been involved with the Northeast Florida Fair for a minimum of two (2) years.

-The applicant must be a high school senior, enrolled or planning to enroll in a college, university, or technical education.

-To be eligible a student must reside in one of the following counties in Florida: Nassau, Duval, Clay, Baker, or St. Johns.

-Scholarship funds will be awarded directly to the winners.
